An imperative sentence begins with the base (first) form of a verb which is also called a verb word. In an imperative sentence, the subject - 'you' - is understood. However, for the first and third-person imperative, the

imperative sentence begins with 'let'. You can end an imperative sentence with the period (.) or exclamation (!). Exclamation is used to show direct and firm command.
